Do I need a power plug adapter in Fiji?

In Fiji, they use power sockets (outlets) of type I, like in Australia. Your plugs fit into the power sockets in Fiji. You don't need a power plug adapter. We don't sell power plug adapters. We refer you to Amazon or Ebay where you will find a great selection of travel adapters.

What type of power outlet does Fiji use?

See our product selection criteria and guidelines here. Which power outlets do they use in Fiji? Fijian plugs and sockets are a Type I; The standard voltage is 240 V and the standard frequency is 50 Hz.

Do US plugs work in Fiji?

No, US plugs typically don't work in Fiji without an adapter. Fiji uses Type I power outlets, which have three flat pins in a triangular pattern. US plugs (Type A and B) have two or three flat parallel pins. To use your US devices in Fiji, you'll need a power adapter.

Does Fiji have a 240V power supply?

It is important to note that it does not convert the voltage or frequency. For Fiji the associated plug type is I, which is the plug that has three flat pins in a triangular pattern. Fiji operates on a 240V supply voltage and 50Hz. Electricity supplies worldwide can vary from anything between 100V and 240V.

Do I need a travel adapter in Fiji?

What most travellers need to know is that Fiji uses an electrical current of 240 volts 50 Hz and accepts Type I (i) plugs, so if your appliances don't fit the electrical outlets and/or require a different voltage or frequency, then you're going to need a travel adapter and maybe even a convertor. Makes sense?

What voltage does Fiji use?

The voltage in Fiji is the same as in Europe. However, Europeans will need a travel adapter when traveling to Fiji. What Outlet does Fiji Use? Type I plug sockets are used in Australia, New Zealand. They have two flat pins and a grounding pin. These plugs are typically used with devices that have a voltage of 230V.

Never touch electrical components immediately after the power supply has been turned off. Electrical shock may occur. After turning off the power, always wait 5 minutes or more before touching electrical components. During installation, make sure that the refrigerant pipe is attached firmly before you run the compressor.
