Who is the project EPC contractor for Mozambique?

Spanish company TSKhas been appointed as project EPC contractor. Globeleq will oversee the construction of the eventual operation of the power plant, supported by Source Energia. Globeleq, Source Energia and EDM start construction on the first IPP in Mozambique to integrate utility-scale energy storage and solar.
