What is the Desert Harvest II solar project - energy storage system?

The Desert Harvest II Solar Project - Energy Storage System is a 35,000kW energy storage project located in California, US. The project was announced in 2018 and will be commissioned in 2021. The Desert Harvest II Solar Project - Energy Storage System is being developed by EDF Renewables.

Who is the developer of Desert Harvest II solar photovoltaic project?

EDF Renewables is the developer. EDF Renewables North America has signed a 25-year Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) with Southern California Public Power Authority (SCPPA) for the energy and renewable attributes related to the 70 MWac /100.8 MWdc Desert Harvest II solar photovoltaic project under a Renewable Energy Credit (REC) +Index structure.

Who is involved in the Edwards & Sanborn solar & energy storage project?

Terra-Gen and Mortenson have announced the activation of the Edwards & Sanborn Solar +Energy Storage project, the largest solar and storage project in the United States. Mortenson served as engineering, procurement, and construction contractor for the project.

How much solar power does California have?

It holds a capacity of 875 MWdc solar, and nearly 3.3 GWh of energy storage. It has a 1.3 GW interconnection capacity. California's grid is expected to receive enough electricity to power the equivalent of about 238,000 homes from the project. This leads to an estimated 320,000 tons of carbon dioxide emissions abated annually.
